Zeman's message for Chovanec



Miloš Zeman doesn't want to let the "tunneling" of OKD by Zdeněk Bakala to go away, and he used an interview with [Blesk TV](#) yesterday to tie the privatization of the mines into the ongoing police reorganization. If the reorganization leads to the [investigation of Bakala](#), he said, he will be pleased. Zeman isn't a president who looks at things in terms of right and wrong, any more than Bohuslav Sobotka is a PM who governs this way. They both make expedient political decisions. Sobotka supports the police reorganization because he sees it as a way to save the skin of high-level ČSSD operatives, including himself. Zeman has given it his lukewarm support for the opposite reason, because he sees it as a way to attack those in ČSSD who opposed him in the past and who still get under his skin. Zeman's message to Interior Min. Milan Chovanec is clear: If you want my full support for the police reform, you must go after Bakala and his enablers.
