## Shop till you drop



Czech retailers are reporting record Christmas sales and, hand-in-hand with this, consumer lenders can be expected to announce record year-end transactions. Yet at the same time, a STEM poll found that 75% of Czechs fear that the 2008 tax and social reforms will worsen their economic situation.
