Sliding into war with Iran

In a perverse sort of way, you have to admire the versatility of Europe's efforts to destroy itself. Any one thing would be enough to put down a weaker organism, but Europe has fought several unwinnable wars, loaded up on debt that can't be repaid, debased its currencies, outsourced its jobs to Asia, and taught its children how not to study, work or eat well, yet it is still looking for other ways to hasten the decline. And so it has declared an embargo on Iranian oil, based in part on a vague claim by the [Int. Atomic Energy Agency](#) that there are "indications that some activities relevant to the development [by Iran] of a nuclear explosive device continued after 2003, and that some may still be ongoing." Zbigniew Brzezinski told the [Financial Times](#) that he fears that Israel might attack Iran in Oct., right before the U.S. elections. He said that it would be [disastrous](#) on a massive scale to slide into a conflict with Iran.
