The city of Brno rejected Amazon's plans this week for a distribution center in the Moravian city, but national and regional politicians are still running around trying to put a deal together. Southern Moravian Gov. Michal Hašek declared yesterday that the project is a strategic matter not only for his region, but also for the entire country. Industry Minister Jan Mládek used slightly less lofty language but still said that such an investment is in the interest of both the region and the country.
