Czexit's biggest supporters



One of Donald Trump's most successful and also most criticized tactics is to create a problem that he then proceeds to fix. Nuclear war with North Korea, trade war with China, government shutdown, Special Olympics funding, you name it, Trump has found a way to avert disaster. A similar tactic is being used for Czexit in the run-up to the EU elections. A [CVVM poll in Feb.](#) found that only 20% of respondents would vote in a referendum to leave the EU, and a new [Median poll for Czech Radio](#) found that merely 30% of Czechs fail to see the benefits of having joined the EU, but Czexit is being presented by some media and politicians (esp. [Economia](#) and [TOP 09](#)) as a real disaster in the making that needs to be averted. Not even [Václav Klaus Jr.](#) plans to include Czexit as one of the tenets of his new party. For Czexit to become a viable Trump-like election topic, it would first have to gain legitimacy as a real solution to the current problems. Is that really what TOP 09 wants?
