PM Andrej Babiš suffered a setback last month when the [Supreme Court](#) overturned a lower-court ruling in a slander suit filed against him by Bison & Rose PR agency. More interesting than the [details of the case](#) itself are the circumstances. Like the [libel lawsuits](#) filed against us by lawyer Radek Pokorný, the legal action against Babiš by Bison & Rose was begun when Bohuslav Sobotka was still the prime minister and Milan Chovanec was the interior minister. Even if Bison & Rose wins its lawsuit after six or seven years of back-in-forth in court and gets an apology from Babiš, what will it have achieved? It will have reminded the public of its role in the near-death of ČSSD, which really isn't the greatest PR outcome.
