## Welcome to Visegrad!



One of the big victories in the parliamentary elections is to steer the CR away from the Hungarian and Polish paths. How is this miracle being achieved? First the Constitutional Court changed the [electoral law](#) so that small parties got a fairer shake ... with the result that a record 19.9% of votes for small parties were wasted. Then one of the election winners, [KDU Chair Marian Jurečka](#), threatened to strip the president of his powers for making a "wrong" political decision about appointing a new prime minister.
