Denial phase



When reporter <u>Darlene Superville of AP</u> mentioned to Joe Biden in Madrid in late June that <u>85% of Americans</u> think their country is headed in the wrong direction and that some world leaders he was meeting with think this too, Biden responded that they do not think that.
"You haven't found one person - one world leader - to say America is going backwards," he said. Both Biden and Fiala, it seems, are in the denial phase.
