Plan T: Blame it on Trump

Pres. Petr Pavel told <u>Czech Radio</u> on Mon., echoing something his adviser <u>Petr Kolář</u> had said on Dec. 21, that we must accept the possibility that Donald Trump will win this year's U.S. presidential elections and then enter into negotiations with Vladimir Putin about Ukraine. We must be prepared for an outcome that isn't favorable to either Ukraine or Europe, he said. That same day Defense Min. Jana Černochová signed a <u>letter of acceptance</u> with U.S. Amb. Donald Trump - who wouldn't even take office until Jan. 20, 2025 - is increasingly being presented as the scapegoat for today's political and military failures. Call it the Plan T. What's missing is a Plan B. What excuse will there be if Joe Biden wins in Nov.?
