


Has PPF had enough?



The Communists are staging a political comeback, after losing representation in the [Senate in 2018](#) and [House in 2021](#). Chair Kateřina Konečná has been holding down the fort for them in the EU Parliament and appears to be on her way to leading the new leftist [Stačilo!/Enough!](#) coalition to a better showing in the June 7-8 EU elections than [KSCM's 6.94% finish in 2019](#). When PPF's TV Nova gives Stačilo! five minutes in its [main evening news](#), as it did last night, it portends a political tremor. Nova has consistently been less pro-government than Czech TV, and it launched a [Sun. debate show](#) that competes directly with [Václav Moravec](#), whose favored party is STAN. Perhaps PPF wants some leverage against [NÚKIB and the new cybersecurity law](#). Perhaps it isn't [on the way out](#), as we wrote in Nov., and is returning to [Petr Kellner's priorities](#) of freedom, remembering PPF's roots and cultivating Czech potential. Instead of accepting the decline and destruction of the country's current direction.
