The budding Babiš-Beneš alliance



A sort of post-Brexit triumvirate of Emmanuel Macron, Friedrich Merz and Keir Starmer is taking shape, and their ambassadors in Prague published an op-ed in HN on Mon. in which they argued against delaying climate measures. Stéphane Crouzat, Andreas Künne and Matt Field wrote that climate change doesn't stop just because of economic or security concerns.
