Businessman Babiš still in action



In business, Andrej Babiš was known for using due diligence to get confidential information from a rival, acting on it to improve his own position and then drawing out the negotiations as the value of the target company began to fall. Babiš is now using similar tactics on Pres. Petr Pavel.
