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Tejc takes aim at Baxa



Chief Justice Josef Baxa of the Constitutional Court is a product of the same American structures as Pres. [Petr Pavel](#), ex-Army Chief of Staff [Karel Řehka](#) and Supreme State Prosecutor [Lenka Bradáčová](#). Donald Trump calls these structures the Deep State, and Andrej Babiš uses the same term for the Czech offshoots. Much was invested by these structures into [grooming](#) Baxa for his current position. He had a curated media presentation that included the publication in 2023 of a [book](#) by some of the people who were closely associated with Pavel's presidential campaign and who helped launch [Deník N](#) while the campaign was being executed. Until now the coalition parties and voters they represent had little reason to take objection to Baxa's work. He even oversaw an [election-law decision](#) that favored the future coalition. Yet with the [Court's ruling](#) on Pavel's participation at the Nato summit, Baxa becomes a major political player. He also becomes a major political target, and Justice Min. [Jeroným Tejc](#) is taking aim.

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
